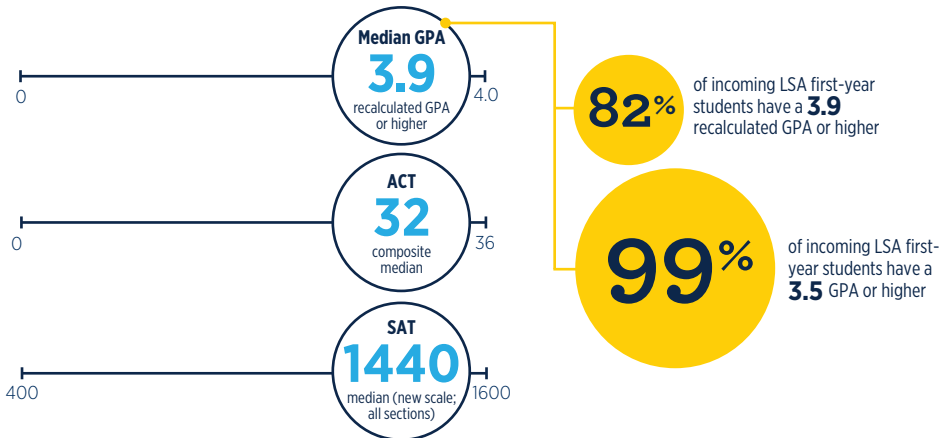

As the largest college at U-M, with **41 programs ranked in the top ten**, LSA continues to build on an established tradition of educational excellence.

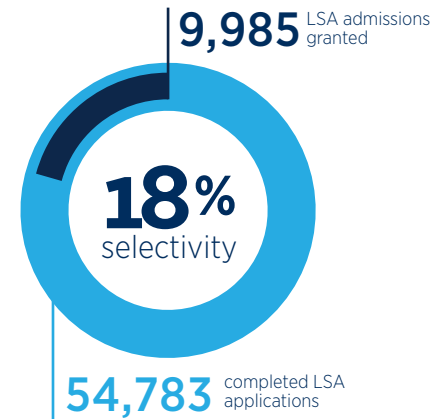


## INCOMING LSA FIRST-YEAR STUDENT STATS



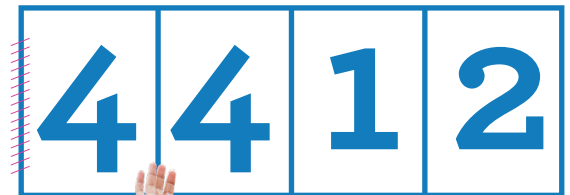

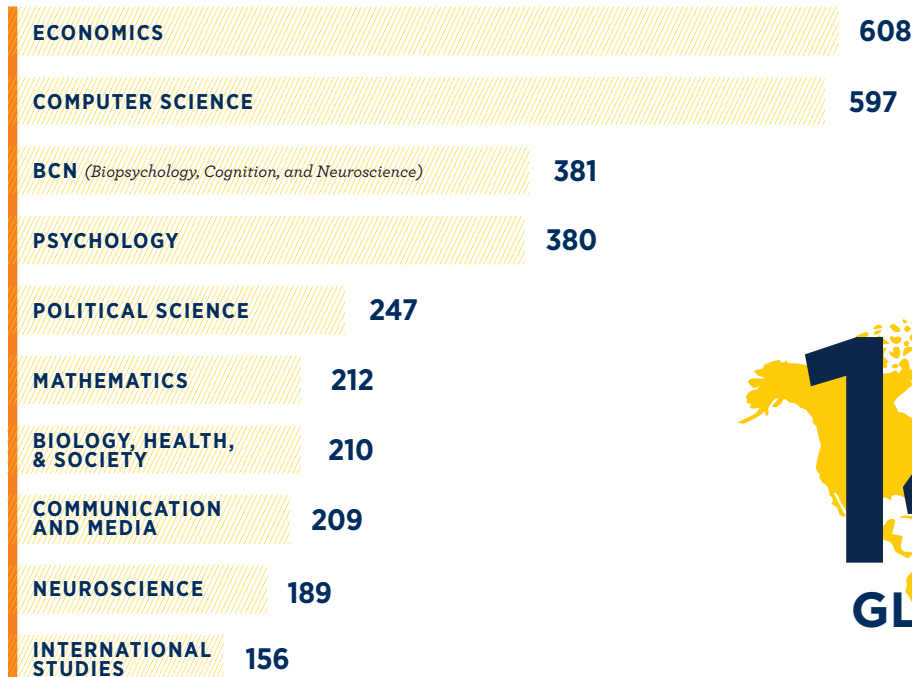

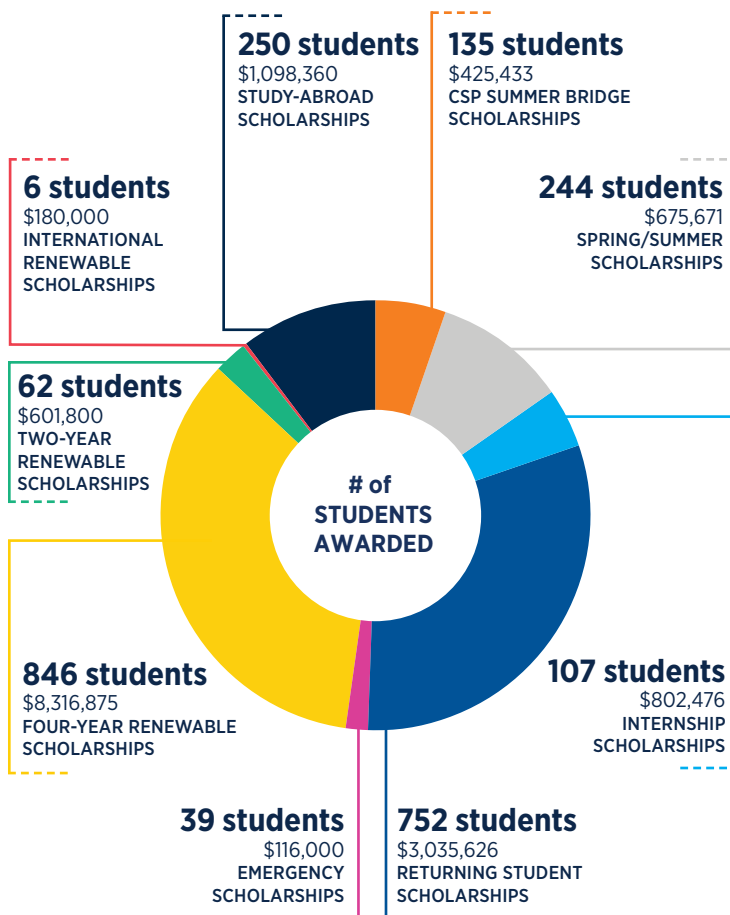

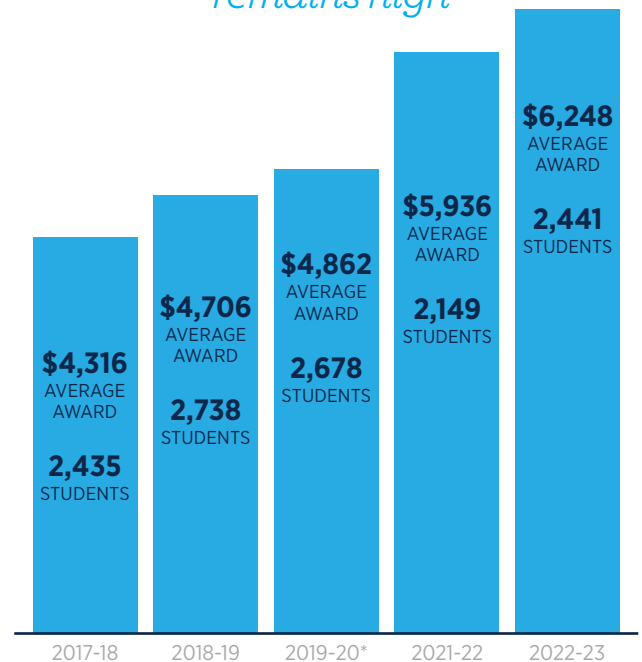
