

Narrator Documentation

Voice over accessibility tool

Description:

Narrator is a screen-reading accessibility app that's built into Windows 10, it lets you use your PC without a mouse. It reads and interacts with things on the screen, like text and buttons. Use this tool whenever you add a new page to your site.

Installing Narrator extension:

Narrator is built into Windows 10, so there's nothing you need to download or install.

Getting Started:

To start using Narrator: Press the Windows logo key + Ctrl + Enter together.

To stop using Narrator: Press the Windows logo key + Ctrl+ Enter together again.

To open Narrator setting: Press the Windows logo key + Ctrl + N together.

To stop Narrator from reading at any time: Press the Ctrl key.

To move around apps and webpages: use the Tab or arrow keys. When you get to something you want to use, like a link, press Enter. You can also use the Tab, arrow, and Enter keys to move between and interact with things like checkboxes and buttons.
