## \*Declaration term of Winter 2014 and After

This is a basic checklist for the American Culture major requirements. Exceptions & substitutions may be approved in consultation with the AC undergraduate advisor. Students are also encouraged to incorporate study abroad and/or the AC Honors program into their plan. All students should meet regularly with the AC advisor to ensure satisfactory progress toward completion of all requirements.
