This year, the symposium is focused on bringing together members of the public with distinguished environmental thinkers. Together, we will explore environmental issues and solutions from a wide range of perspectives, including science, technology, humanities, and policy.

Guidelines for Submissions:

We encourage students from all disciplines (natural sciences, social sciences, and humanities) and levels (graduate, undergraduate, and K-12) to submit posters to the session. Posters must be related to environmental science and policy, and they must include a section explaining why their content is significant to members of the public.

The deadline for submissions is February 23, 2018, at 5 pm. Authors of accepted posters will be notified by March 3rd.
