Major Checklist

Prerequisites:

- Either LATIN 231 (honors section*), LATIN 232, LATIN 233, LATIN 295, RCLANG 295, or special placement examination

Requirements:

A minimum of nine (9) courses of at least 3 credits each from the following categories:

1. **Seven** courses in Latin at the 300-level or above; at least 4 of these courses must be at the 400-level or above and must include at least one, but not more than two, of the entry level advanced courses (i.e., LATIN 401, 402, 409, and 410). No more than 3 credits of Latin 499 may be used. Students must obtain permission from the advisor before electing.
