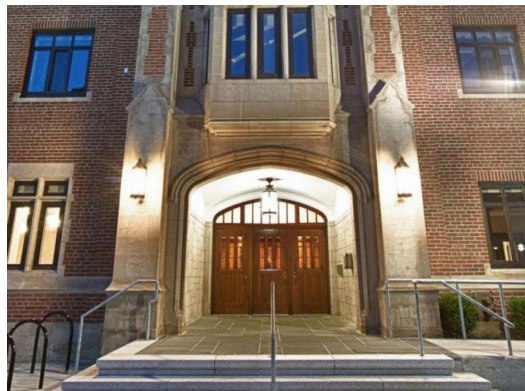


*How's your senior year going?*

2. **For summer term financial aid consideration, we strongly encourage the completion of the 2021-2022 FAFSA as soon as possible, but no later than June 1. 3. **By May 1, accept your admission and submit your \$300 enrollment deposit by May 1st, 2022 through [Enrollment Connect](#). There are options to [request an extension or waiver](#) through the Office of Undergraduate Admissions.**
