Tenured and tenure-track faculty are eligible.

Tenured and tenure-track faculty and lecturers II/III/IV are eligible.
<b>TOME (Toward an Open Monograph Ecosystem)</b> <a href="https://www.lib.umich.edu/tome/about-tome">https://www.lib.umich.edu/tome/about-tome</a>	\$15,000	Rolling Deadline	This program supports open access to peer-reviewed digital monographs that are free of digital rights management (DRM) restrictions. Instructional/Research Faculty, Librarians, Curators, and Archivists are eligible. Lecturers and postdocs are not currently eligible.
<b>ADVANCE SUCCEED</b> <a href="https://advance.umich.edu/succeed/">https://advance.umich.edu/succeed/</a>	\$10,000	March 2020 (expected)	This program supports tenure-track and tenured faculty in the arts, humanities, and social sciences with career needs (e.g., research travel, childcare during research travel, book editing, professional development such as workshops, and supplies).
<b>Humanities Collaboratory: Proposal Development Grants</b> <a href="https://sites.lsa.umich.edu/collaboratory/grants/proposal-development-grants/">https://sites.lsa.umich.edu/collaboratory/grants/proposal-development-grants/</a>	\$45,000-\$85,000	February 3, 2020	This program provides support (e.g., summer ninth, meeting expenses) for project teams to develop cohesive collaborative project grant proposals during May and June of each year. Tenured and tenure-track faculty are eligible for PI status. Lecturers are eligible to participate on research teams.

(Note: This program may support a course release for the PI and/or a summer ninth). Tenured and tenure-track faculty are eligible for PI status. Lecturers are eligible to participate on research teams.
<b>Associate Professor Support Fund</b> Available through the LSA Gateway: Research > Funding > Internal LSA Programs	\$30,000 (amounts over \$30k require 25% cost sharing)	March 2020 (expected)	This programs supports LSA associate professors to help them prepare for promotion to full professor. In the humanities, this program supports summer ninths, course "buy downs," GSRAs, editing/translation work, or funds to travel to a distant site.
<b>Michigan Humanities Award</b> Available through the LSA Gateway: Research > Funding > Internal LSA Programs	A scholarly activity leave for one term with salary.	October 2020 (expected)	This program provides a scholarly activity leave for one term with salary. Applicants must be tenured, full-time LSA faculty members in the humanities or social sciences.
