

GENDER AND FEMINIST PSYCHOLOGY

This Curriculum Guide **is not** a major or minor plan; it is a list of recommended courses for students interested in studying gender and other psychology issues from a feminist perspective, and who are also interested in women's studies, sociology, public policy, social work and health related fields.

Note on Pre-requisites: Many of these courses have pre-requisites. Please refer to the current LSA Course Guide for information regarding which courses are required. It is important that pre-requisites are taken early in a student's academic career so that they will be completed in time to take the desired course.
