### PREREQUISITE COURSE

#### RCLANG 324

- Students who do not take Spanish 277:
  - First RCLANG 324 = Spanish 277
  - Second RCLANG 324 = 300-level elective
  - Third RCLANG 324 = 300-level elective
- Students who take Spanish 277:
  - First RCLANG 324 = 300-level elective
  - Second RCLANG 324 = 300-level elective

#### Spanish AP Credit/IB Credit

- Spanish 279x can count toward the Spanish major at the 279-399 level

#### Cognate Course (optional)

- One cognate course may be included in the major. Please see the RLL website for a list of approved cognate courses.

#### Study Abroad Courses

- A pre- evaluation and final evaluation of study abroad courses is required. Make an appointment with a Spanish faculty advisor on the RLL website.

#### Independent Studies & Internships

- No more than one independent study and one internship (6 credits) can be counted toward the major without approval of the Spanish Undergraduate Curriculum Committee.

#### Residence Requirement

- A maximum of 5 out-of-residence (15 credits) courses are permitted. All other courses/credits must be in-residence: taken on UM campus or with a study abroad program affiliated with UM (CGIS).

## Spanish Major

### Prerequisites for the Major

- Spanish 277 (or 278)
- Residential College students may take RCLANG 324 as an equivalent to Spanish 277.
  - Please review the Language Placement tab on the RLL website for further information about [RC equivalencies](#).

### Major Requirements

- 10 courses of at least three credits each, beyond the prerequisites, including:
  - A maximum of 5 Spanish courses numbered 279-399.
  - A minimum of 5 Spanish courses numbered 400-499.
- One cognate course (3 credits) may be counted toward the Spanish major. *Please see the RLL website for a list of approved cognate courses.*
- No more than one independent study and one internship (6 credits) can be counted toward the major without approval of the Spanish Undergraduate Curriculum Committee.
- It is possible to take your third 279-399 course concurrently with your first 400-level course. Students must contact [rll.mailbox@umich.edu](mailto:rll.mailbox@umich.edu) to make this request.

### Residence Requirement

- A maximum of 5 out-of-residence courses are permitted. All other courses/credits must be in-residence: taken on UM campus or with a study abroad program affiliated with UM (CGIS).
