

Writing Award Submission Guidelines

Eita Krom Prize \$500

Submission Requirements: An essay 10 to 25 pages in length on a sociological topic written by an <u>LSA junior or senior</u>. The essay must have a unique title and not bear the name of a class assignment. A submission with a title like *Paper 1*, for example, will not be considered.

Submission Restrictions: Entries cannot be group-authored papers nor excerpts from Honors theses. Please do not submit response papers or project proposals.

Submission Process & Guidelines: Submit your entry via email in PDF format to socadvisor@umich.edu. Make the name of the document as close to the title of your paper as possible. The body of your email must include:

- The name of the award for which you are submitting your paper
- Your UM-ID number
- The semester in which the paper was written
- The class for which the paper was written
- The name and email address of the instructor (and GSI, if applicable)

<u>DO NOT</u> include your name or any other identifying information on the document you submit. Be sure to delete headers or footers that include your UM-ID or name. Remove any instances of the title of the class, instructors, and semester dates.

Mark Chesler Student Research Award \$250

Submission requirements: An essay 10 to 35 pages in length that contributes to the sociological understanding of <u>diversity</u>, <u>social justice</u>, <u>participatory action research</u>, <u>intergroup relations</u>, <u>or service learning</u>. The essay must have a unique title and not bear the name of a class assignment. A submission with a title like *Paper 1*, for example, will not be considered.

Submission restrictions: Entries cannot be group-authored. Please do not submit response papers or project proposals.

Submission process and guidelines: Submit your entry via email in PDF format to socadvisor@umich.edu. Make the name of the document as close to the title of your paper as possible. The body of your email must include:

- The name of the award for which you are submitting your paper
- Your UM-ID number
- The semester in which the paper was written
- The class for which the paper was written
- The name and email address of the instructor (and GSI, if applicable)

<u>DO NOT</u> include your name or any other identifying information on the document you submit. Be sure to delete headers or footers that include your UM-ID or name. <u>Remove</u> any instances of the title of the class, class instructors, and semester dates.
